Members Credit Union (MCU) is proud to offer two \$500 scholarships for the 2019-2020 school year. Any credit union member is eligible to apply for a scholarship. Any student who lives, works or attends school in Fairfield County, CT is eligible to join the credit union.

The following criteria will be used in selecting the student to receive the award.

- Applicant must be a credit union member. Length of membership will be considered.
- Student must demonstrate financial need. If qualifications are equal, financial need will predominate.
- Applicant must be a full-time student currently enrolled in or accepted to a college/undergraduate program.
- Applicant must have at least a 3.0 grade point average

The Scholarship Committee will select the winner. Applications will be rated on the following criteria: essay, grades, financial need, special needs, length of membership and extracurricular activities.

Students must submit the following items with the completed application. All items requested must be received in order for the application to qualify for consideration.

A typed, double spaced essay. Choose one of the two suggested essays.

An official high school or college transcript.

Any other information that would be helpful to the committee should be included as an attachment.

Deadline: Applications and accompanying material must be mailed to the Credit Union no later than May 3, 2019. Winners will be notified by May 24, 2019.
